Example 1: Epic's part offers improved design. (120972) = EE401886 Belt, Motor Drive, 1350 mm X 100 mm, Kevlar, 05, BA3/BA4/BA5. Epic's core yarn is Kevlar, doesn't stretch and wears longer. We've had customers tell us estimated life is 3-4 times longer and worth the additional cost.


Example 2: Epic's part serves the same function, but may differ from original design. (941583) = EE480464 Thread Guide Roller Assembly with 6 mm Stud, 05-09, BA3-BA5, **Epic Style.** This item has a replaceable bearing (EE401181), the threaded stud has a lex recessed socket, and the "head" has a screwdriver slot for quick installation.

Example 3: Epic part is a component of an assembly where no reference number is available: 443408 = EE480195 Brake Shoe Assembly, 06-09, BA4.
